महाशय,

उपर्युक्त विषय के सम्बन्ध में दैनिक समाचार पत्र में प्रकाशित खबर जिसके अनुसार तीन दिव्यांग बच्चों के पिता द्वारा सपरिवार इच्छा मृत्यु माँगने सम्बन्धित प्रेस कतरन की प्रति संलग्न करते हुए कहना है कि प्रकाशित समाचार के अवलोकन से विदित होता है कि रोहतास जिले के सझौली प्रखण्ड के घुलकार गाँव के निवासी श्री देवमुनी सिंह जो पेशे से कृषक हैं, के तीन पुत्रों का सही ढंग से ईलाज नहीं होने के कारण विकलांग हो गए। पुत्रों के ईलाज के क्रम में उनकी सारी पुश्तैनी जमीन बिक चुकी है। अब जीविका निर्वाहन में काफी कठिनाइयों का सामना करना पड़ रहा है। बी०पी०एल० सूची में नाम नहीं अंकित रहने के कारण सरकार द्वारा प्रदत्त सारी योजना तथा आयुष्मान योजना का लाभ इनके परिवार को नहीं मिल पा रहा है, जिससे अत्यन्त बेबस और लाचार हैं।

समस्याओं के सम्बन्ध में माननीय प्रधानमंत्री एवं मुख्यमंत्री, बिहार को अवगत कराते हुए इस सम्बन्ध में दिव्यांग बच्चों के पिता द्वारा सपरिवार इच्छा मृत्यु की अनुमति माँगी है। यह लोक कल्याणकारी राज्य के लिए अत्यन्त ही गंभीर विषय है।

दिव्यांगों के पुनर्वास के सम्बन्ध में दिव्यांगजन अधिकार अधिनियम, 2016 के अध्याय-5 जो दिव्यांगों को सामाजिक सुरक्षा, स्वास्थ्य, स्वास्थ्य पुनर्वास आदि व्यवस्था से सम्बन्धित है, की कंडिका-24(1), 3(क) (ग) एवं (च) आदि पर किये गए प्रावधान के तहत मामले पर संज्ञान लेकर संबंधित पदाधिकारी को आवश्यक निर्देश देने की कृपा की जाय ताकि किसी प्रकार की कोई अप्रिय घटना न हो। दिव्यांगजन अधिकार अधिनियम, 2016 की धारा-37 के अन्तर्गत गरीबी उन्मूलन योजनाओं में 05 प्रतिशत दिव्यांगों की भागीदारी सुनिश्चित करने का प्रावधान है एवं धारा-38 के तहत गंभीर दिव्यांगजनों के लिए उच्च सहायता की आवश्यकता को देखते हुए विशेष सहायता की आवश्यकता प्रतीत होता है।

अधोहस्ताक्षरी द्वारा भी मामले की गंभीरता को ध्यान में रखकर दिनांक-27.07.2019 को पीड़ित परिवार से मिलकर उनकी समस्याओं के निष्पादन हेतु आवश्यक लाभ दिलवाने हेतु प्रयास की आवश्यकता महसूस की गई है।

अनुरोध है कि प्रासंगिक मामले में लिए गए निर्णय से अधोहस्ताक्षरी को अवगत कराने की कृपा की जाय।

Broke and broken, father of 3 children pleads for euthanasia

ON THE BRINK Family writes to PM, says the government has failed to provide help

A penurious family in Bihar's Sasaram town in Khatas district, pleading for euthanasia, has written a letter to Prime Minister Narendra Modi as the government has failed to arrange for the treatment of its three sons suffering from rare congenital muscular disease that has left them paralysed at juvenile ages.

The landless farmer, Devmuni Singh Yadav, resident of Chhalkar village, says that he has lost everything he had in the treatment of his three sons — Mantosh, 14, Dhantosh, 11 and Ramtosh, 7, — but to no avail as the disease requires treatment at specialised hospital in the metros and he doesn't have the resources.

Politicians and administrative officials, he rues, have only been giving him false assurances.

The poor farmer, forced to live in a thatched hutment along with his wife, daughter and the three physically impaired sons after he sold all his belongings including the 10 katha of ancestral cultivable land and 4 decimal homestead land, said that none in his family wants to lead this cursed life anymore and hence they have written a letter to the PM for the permission to end it.

Yadav's saga is indeed heart rendering. Life was happy for him and his family of six members till 2012 when the eldest son, Mantosh then eight, began undergoing unusual changes in his hands and feet. "They started becoming thinner and weak eventually rendering him bed ridden," he said.

The family had sold all the land, ornaments, and precious belongings to pay ₹1 lakh bank loan and ₹4 lakh loan taken from villagers on much high rates of interest.

The biggest problem is unavailability of a toilet. We lift the children on our shoulders and take them to the nearby fields to attend to nature's call, at least twice a day.

local quacks and doctors at Sasaram besides a physiotherapist at Dehri. But recovery remained elusive," Yadav said.

After arranging some money, he then took the boy to BHU at Varanasi where doctors pre-

sent him to a private hospital. He had the same symptoms. Soon his hands and feet too stopped working. Burdened with another patient at home, the poor man sold off his 10 katha ancestral land at throwaway price to meet the medical emergency. He was running to

villagers on much high rates of interest. Rendered penniless, the family moved to a thatched hutment, which is deprived of basic amenities like toilet, water and a proper roof overhead.

When this correspondent reached Yadav's dwelling, 38km distance from Sasaram, the 10/8 feet room thatched hutment

He says, "The biggest problem is unavailability of a toilet. We could not arrange money for it, construction. My wife, Anita, daughter Madhu, 16, and I lift the three disabled children on our shoulders and take them to the nearby fields at least twice a day. We also have to clean their bodies after the morning and evening ablutions."

Two of the elder brothers were getting disability pension of ₹400 since last year and ₹5kg ration for per member under Khadya Suraksha scheme after local journalist raised the issue before authorities. "But it is like a drop in the ocean," Yadav said.
