Sub: 3rd Short Term Training Programme on Basic Skills in Indian Sign Language from 10th-26th June 2019.

Dear Sir/ Madam,

Indian Sign Language Research and Training Centre (ISLRTC) is an Autonomous organization of the Government of India under the aegis of Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (Divyangjan), Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India, New Delhi.

ISLRTC runs a 2 year Diploma in Indian Sign Language Interpreting Course (DISLI) which is recognized by RCI. Considering the requests received to conduct training in Indian Sign Language from various States and organizations, ISLRTC has prepared a **Short Term Training Programme on Basic Skills in Indian Sign Language (15 days)**. Two batches of the training programme have been successfully completed.

ISLRTC now invites nominations from Govt Departments (Centre/State), PSUs, Non-Government Organizations, Schools, Teachers, Special Educators, professionals from fields of legal, medical, technical and academic and individuals to attend the **3rd Short Term Training Programme on Basic Skills in Indian Sign Language** from 10th – 26th June 2019 at ISLRTC, New Delhi. The duration of the programme is 15 working days (Monday-Saturday) with 6 training hours each day (Total: 90 hours).

The fee for the said training programme is Rs.12,500/- per participant (which includes 2 times tea/refreshments, lunch, & training kit with ISL Dictionary of 6000 words). To get confirmation of participation, it is advisable to pay the prescribed fees of Rs. 12,500/- ISLRTC by NEFT in advance. The fees can also be paid by Demand Draft drawn in favour of '**Indian Sign Language Research and Training Centre**' payable at New Delhi. The DD for fees will need to be submitted by the participants on the first day of the training, failing which they will not be allowed to attend the training programme.

Accommodation and travel arrangements will need to be borne by the sponsoring organization/ individuals/ concerned department. No TA/DA will be paid by ISLRTC to the participants of the said training programme.

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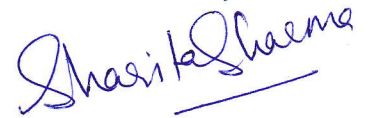
It is requested that nominations from concerned departments/ organizations/individuals from your state for this training programme on the scheduled date may kindly be forwarded in the enclosed nomination form. The form must be duly signed by the Sponsoring Authority and sent by email to Programme Nodal Officer, Dr. Sharita Sharma at sharitasharma@gmail.com latest by 31st May, 2019.

The maximum batch size is 20. If minimum nominations of 15 are not received, the training programme will be rescheduled. So, preferably minimum 3 officials or non-government personnel (teachers, special educators, NGOs, professionals from fields of legal, medical, technical and academic and individuals) may be nominated from your Department/State/organizations/individuals for the 3rd batch of the training programme.

The confirmation to the nomination of the candidates, will be published on the ISLRTC website by 3rd June 2019. The sponsoring authority and the candidates will be intimated by e-mail on the mail id provided by them on the nomination form. All sponsoring authorities are requested to ensure that only those candidates whose nominations have been confirmed for the Programme shall be relieved to attend it.
